What's available?

Facility	Yes/No	Detail
Café	Yes	Seasonal cafe at Dingo Dell, open 10am-3pm daily over the months of July and August.
Drinking water	Yes	Available from the café during seasonal opening times
Picnic tables/shelters	Yes	Nine locations
BBQ/fireplace	Yes	Fire places at Eurobin Creek Picnic Area, Rollasons Falls Picnic Area, Grossmans Mill Picnic Area, Lake Catani Day Visitor Area and Campground.
Family friendly accommodation	Yes	Summer camping between October and May at Lake Catani Campground. Unpowered sites, toilet block with hot water showers and kitchen/laundry sink facilities. Fees apply.
Toilets	Yes	All major day visitor areas: Eurobin Creek Picnic Area, Rollasons Falls Picnic Area, Gorge Day Visitor Area, Lake Catani Day Visitor Area and Campground, Cathedral Picnic Area.
Baby changing facilities/ disabled toilets	Yes	Baby change facilities and disabled toilets at Gorge Day Visitor Area, also disable toilet facilities at Lake Catani Campground (seasonal access only between October and May)
Children's playground	No	Nature's playground only!
Open space areas (for sports activities etc.)	Yes	The Oval Picnic Area on the plateau below the Gorge Day Visitor Area. Adjacent to carpark.
Walking tracks suitable for prams	Yes	In and around Gorge Day Visitor Area and Lake Catani Day Visitor Area.
Child friendly bikes tracks	No	Go walking, swimming or canoeing in summer, or tobogganing in winter instead!

Play ideas

- Take to the snow in winter for toboggan racing and snowman building.
- Try kayaking, bushwalking and camping at Lake Catani during the warmer weather.
- Follow the wombat trail in search of these cute but reclusive marsupials. You may even find echidnas and lyrebirds too.
- Discover the grand but creepy old Mt Buffalo Ski Chalet – what would it have been like to live here?
