Just a short drive from Warrnambool, Tower Hill boasts an ancient crater and other volcanic landforms. Abundant wildlife makes the park well worth the drive.

Café	Yes	Tower Hill Visitor Centre, open 9am - 4pm. Light refreshments, coffee, drinks available.
Drinking water	Yes	Bottled water available at the Visitor Centre
Picnic tables/shelters	Yes	Picnic tables in picnic area, near the carpark.
BBQ/fireplace	Yes	One electric BBQ in the picnic area
Family friendly accommodation	No	A range of accommodation available in Warrnambool
Toilets	Yes	In the picnic area
Baby changing facilities/ disabled toilets	No	Bring a change mat with you
Children's playground	No	Nature's playground only!
Open space areas (for sports activities etc.)	Yes	In the picnic area
Walking tracks suitable for prams	Yes	Lava Tongue Boardwalk, accessed by walking 400m from the picnic ground or from the small Lava Tongue Boardwalk car park.
Child friendly bikes tracks	No	Wheel about with the wildlife instead!

- Pack a hamper and a Frisbee for a relaxing al fresco lunch at the picnic ground.
