What's available?

Facility	Yes/No	Detail
Café	Yes	Open 10.00 - 4.00: refreshments, sandwiches, pies, one hot meal a day. There is also a restaurant at The Mansion Hotel.
Drinking water	Yes	Taps next to the main car park, in the picnic area, next to Lake and Grotto, near the mansion and at the farm.
Picnic tables/shelters	Yes	Large rotundas, picnic tables and chairs in the picnic area alongside Victoria State Rose Garden next to the main car park.
BBQ/fireplace	Yes	Six BBQs in the picnic area
Family friendly accommodation	No	Accommodation at the Werribee Hotel in nearby Werribee, or an easy day from Melbourne.
Toilets	Yes	In the main picnic area, at the entrance to formal gardens, next to mansion and next to the farm.
Baby changing facilities/ disabled toilets	Yes	Disabled toilets in the picnic area, next to mansion and next to the farm.
Children's playground	No	Nature's playground only!
Open space areas (for sports activities etc.)	Yes	Main picnic area
Walking tracks suitable for prams	Yes	Small gravel roads
Child friendly bikes tracks	No	No riding in the park
